

## Improving MPO and SHSO Coordination on Behavioral Traffic Safety: Guide and

Toolkit – This report provides guidance for Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs) and State Highway Safety Offices (SHSOs) to improve coordination on local and regional behavioral safety efforts to

reduce the frequency and severity of traffic crashes. The guide and toolkit provide evidence-based information and resources to help improve coordination between SHSOs and MPOs on behavioral traffic safety.

guidance to help affected agencies plan for and mitigate related safety problems. The project includes tools, policy alternatives, educational materials, institutional requirements and other relevant techniques to mitigate identified risks.

Users – This toolkit helps traffic safety practitioners communicate safe behavior practices to vulnerable road users (VRUs). Pedestrians, cyclists, scooter riders and motorcyclists all lack the basic safety protections provided to vehicle occupants by automobiles, and their fatality rates remain unacceptably high.




Combined High-Visibility Enforcement (HVE):
Determining the Effectiveness – This research
project provides a scalable evaluation framework
and methodologies to determine the effectiveness
of a combination of law enforcement and public
engagement in reducing crashes and their
severity. Researchers explored behavioral safety
issues such as impaired driving, lack of seat belt
use, distracted driving and speeding.
