


THE 5 W'S: A QUICK REVIEW

WHY: Historic number of traffic fatalities in 2023






PIERCE COUNTY ROAD USER FATAL CRASHES




PIERCE COUNTY DISTRACTED DRIVING SERIOUS INJURY AND FATAL CRASHES






SOME ROADS ARE MORE DANGEROUS THAN OTHERS


























STRONG MEDIA INTEREST
